Dear Parent/Carer

On Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August, Grade 3 & 4 students will participate in the District Gala Day event as part of our sporting program.

The aims of the activity are to allow students to try new sports and to work with students from surrounding schools.

### Activity details:

Students have selected their activity from a range of sports (Hockey, Oztag, Netball, Soccer and AFL). This is an all day event and **students must wear YSS uniform, bucket hat and sunscreen** (please ensure all apparel and equipment are visibly named). **Students will need to bring their lunch and water bottles.** Throughout Term 2 students have been involved with Friday afternoon sports to develop specific skills and learn rules associated with their chosen sport. Below is information regarding the sport your child has selected to participate in.

- **AFL:** Bombers AFL ground. Activity involves modified games of AFL organised in a round robin format. This activity is categorised as medium risk level. **Mouthguards are compulsory and appropriate footwear** should be worn. Students will be performing skills specific in modified AFL games such as wrap around tackles (**bumping and sling tackles are not permitted**), kicking, catching and handball passing.
- **Hockey:** Tavistock Street Hockey Fields. Activity involves games organised in a round robin format. This activity is categorised as medium risk level. **Mouthguards and shin pads are compulsory and appropriate footwear** should be worn. Students will be performing basic hockey skills in games organised in a round robin format such as dribbling, trapping, passing, shooting and defending.
- **Soccer:** Tavistock Street Soccer Fields. Activity involves games of soccer organised in a round robin format. This activity is categorised as medium risk level. **Students must wear shin pads WITH LONG SOCKS and are encouraged to wear a mouthguard.** Students will be performing skill specific to soccer such as dribbling, kick pass and shooting, trapping, basic tackle, (**slide tackles are not permitted**) and goal keeping.
- **Netball:** PCYC Hervey Bay. Activity involves games of netball organised in a round robin format. This activity is categorised as medium risk level. **Students need to wear appropriate shoes for hard courts.** Students will be performing netball skills such as passing, catching, shooting, defending and running.
- **Oztag:** Stafford Park: Activity involves games of Oztag organised in a round robin format. This activity is categorised as medium risk level. **Students need to wear appropriate shoes.** They will require Oztag belt and tags which will be provided. Students will be performing skills specific to the sport such as tagging, evading, passing, kicking, catching and play the ball.
- Teachers familiar with the sports will be accompanying the students to their sport and games will be run by registered teachers from Hervey District schools with knowledge and experience of the game.
- Transport: All students will be transported to venues by coach and in the company of class teachers.
- Teachers will be in charge of any medication and will have first aid kits available and medical forms to ensure teachers are aware of any medical requirements.
