



## Palba-Burrum Heads Road, Scrub Hill Road and Wide Bay Drive upgrade

### Project overview

The Department of Transport and Main Roads will soon commence construction to upgrade the Palba-Burrum Heads Road, Scrub Hill Road and Wide Bay Drive intersection in Eli Waters.

The construction contract has been awarded to Hazell Bros Group Pty Ltd who will use a significant proportion of local subcontractors and suppliers to deliver the work.

The \$26 million project is being funded by the Queensland Government's Royalties for the Regions program.

### Construction impacts

Construction will commence in the coming days and will take about twelve months to complete, weather permitting. While the department will work closely with its contractor to keep impacts to a minimum, some disruption to traffic is unavoidable.

Motorists are advised to allow additional travel time as reduced lanes, stop-go traffic controllers and reduced speed limits will be in place throughout the project. Residents can anticipate some noise and dust impacts throughout construction and there will be a combination of day and night works to complete this upgrade. Directly impacted residents will be notified prior to undertaking night works.
