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Activity Consent Form – Year 5 and 6 Camp 28th-30th August 2017

Dear Parent/Carer

On 28th – 30th August 2017, we will be participating in a Year 5 and 6 Camp as part of our Leadership and You Can Do It Program.

The aims of the activity are develop leadership, team work and social skills.

Camp details:

The Camp will be from 28th to 30th August 2017:

- Students and staff will depart Yarrilee State School at 7:30 am on Monday 28th August 2017 for Maranatha Recreation and Education Camp, Yandina and return to Yarrilee State School at approximately 3:30pm on Wednesday 30th August 2017
- Students and staff will participate in activities that range from a low to medium level of risk
- Year 5 students will be participating in a Jungle Ropes Course, Leap of Faith, Jacobs Ladder, Tower of Tremble, Pool sports, Challenge Trail and a Campfire Experience
- Year 6 students will be participating in Mid Ropes Course (including Flying Fox), Abseiling, Possum Pull, Jacobs Ladder, River Rafting, Archery and Minute 2 Win IT
- Students will be required to use ropes at heights (which they will have qualified instructors, harnesses and helmets for), pools and water activities and sporting equipment such as arrows for archery (which will have fully qualified instructors and assessed for risks)
- All activities take place outdoors at the Maranatha Recreation and Education Camp grounds. Sunscreen and insect repellent will be regularly applied throughout each day
- All risk assessment and control measures will be fulfilled by Yarrilee State School and Maranatha Recreation and Education Camp. Maranatha Recreation and Education Camp employs qualified instructors for each activity undertaken by students
- Students will be travelling to and from camp by buses fitted with lap sash seatbelts and air conditioning
- Students will be required to wear sun safe clothing at all times, a YSS hat and closed in sneakers. An equipment list will be provided to each camp participant in the upcoming weeks
- Students must bring clearly labelled water bottles that can be refilled each day and sunscreen and/or insect repellant if they may have allergies or skin sensitivities
- Students requiring medication whilst on camp must provide clearly labelled medication to a staff member attending camp. On the label must be the student's name, dosage of medication, when the medication is to be taken and expiry date of medication
- Students who have changed any emergency, medical or personal information must have a completed update signed by a parent or guardian prior to camp. The attached permission form must be returned the school office or student's teacher prior to camp departure.
- Any dietary requirements or food allergies must be relayed to your child's teacher before camp departure to enable Maranatha Recreation and Education Camp to cater for all students

As per Yarrilee State School's Behaviour Policy, attendance at this camp is only available for students who are Behaviour Level 3,2,1 or those level 4 students who are successfully engaging with their pre camp behaviour contract.

Camp Costs:

The final cost for the Year 5 and 6 camp is \$235. We would appreciate full payment by Monday 14th August 2017 so we can finalise camp plans. This money can be paid in instalments if you wish. Please see our Business Services Manager (Ann Ney) if you wish to do this.
